➔ Mr Yu and his team are responsible for managing the iconic Hangzhou Bay Bridge, a 36km cable stayed bridge which spans the Hangzhou Bay and links Shanghai (China's largest city) to Ningbo (China's 2nd largest port). 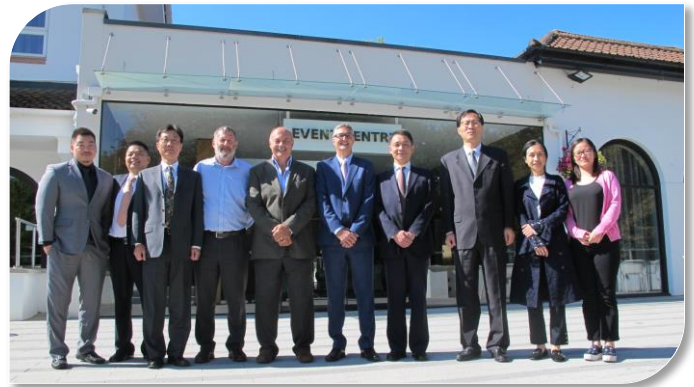
